

# BEREAN CHRISTIAN HIGH SCHOOL Non-Tuition Fee Billing Typical Schedule

BILLED SEPARATELY FROM TUITION, DUE THE 20TH OF EACH MONTH

Following are the *typical* months some of the most common non-tuition charges are billed as due. Actual timing of charges may vary from schedule shown.

- Fall Social tickets (later orders)
- Fall Sports base fee (2/2)
- Fall Sports extra charges (split if \$300 or more)
- Homecoming tickets (early orders)
- SAT/ACT/PSAT/College Essay Seminars

# November

- Bus billing October bus rides
- Yearbooks (auto-billed one per student, reversed upon request if do not want)
- Chorale/ALS clothing
- Homecoming tickets (later orders)
- Student Government fundraiser purchases

## **December**

- Bus billing November bus rides
- ALS Choir Tour (1st half of January event)
- Student Government fundraiser purchases
- Winter Sports base fee (split if \$350)
- Winter Sports extra charges (split if \$300 or more)
- Yearbook senior tribute order (early orders)

#### January

- ALS Choir Tour (2<sup>nd</sup> half)
- AP test fees
- Bus billing December bus rides
- Chorale tour (1st half of Feb. event)
- Class fees second semester
- Part-time student semester fee
- Winter Social tickets
- Winter sports base fee (2<sup>nd</sup> half, if applicable)
- Winter sports extra charges (2<sup>nd</sup> half, if applicable)
- Yearbook senior tribute orders (later orders)

#### February

- Bus billing January bus rides
- Chorale tour (2<sup>nd</sup> half)
- Winter Social tickets
- Yearbook senior tribute orders (later orders)

#### March

- Bus billing February bus rides
- Spring Sports base fee (split if \$350)
- Spring Sports extra charges (split if \$300 or more)

#### April

- Bus billing March bus rides
- JSB tickets (earlier orders)
- Spring Sports base fee (split if \$350)
- Spring Sports extra charges (2<sup>nd</sup> half if applicable)

### May

- Bus billing April bus rides
- Spring Sports charges remaining (if applicable, TBD)
- JSB tickets (later orders)

# June (year-end)

- Bus billing May bus rides
- Fines for missing or damaged school resources assessed at year-end checkout (iPad-related, textbooks, uniforms)

IMPORTANT: year-end report cards (and diplomas for seniors) are not released until account has been paid in full. Families with potential for any of the above charges, or any past due prior months' balance, are encouraged NOT to wait until June to pay any balance due but to plan to either estimate and pay ahead or pay the charges as soon as they are posted to the billing system in late May.

## Variable timing—

Various other potential charges typically billed in first available invoicing cycle after event include, but are not limited to: Sports team banquets or other special team events, class field trips, Club dues/charges, iPad repair charges, additional PE or Weights clothes, additional Spirit Store items, additional fundraiser purchases billed, Senior lunches, Class Socials, Shakespeare class trip, test proctoring fees, optional test prep seminar fees, late or missing uniform charges, late or nsf payment charges, replacement book fines, school event tickets billed, additional cheerleading expenses, etc.

# **Re-enrollment fee (January-February):**

The annual re-enrollment fee is *not* billed to the family account but is collected online separately during the parent-completed FACTS-SIS (RenWeb) re-enrollment process. Berean re-enrollment is open January—February at the regular rate (per the Tuition & Fee schedule). While Berean encourages and appreciates completion of re-enrollment as early as possible, we understand some families may need to time its completion, which includes payment of the fee, according to their other financial obligations, hence the 2-month window of opportunity at the regular rate. But note that on March 1 the re-enrollment fee increases by \$100 AND student's enrollment slot is no longer guaranteed.
